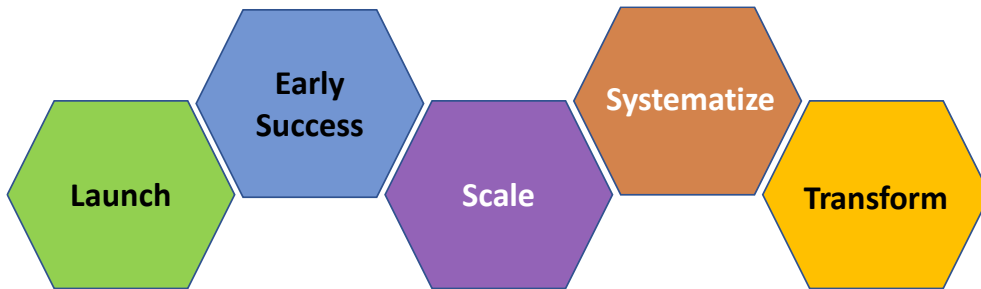

## The Lean Six Sigma Champion

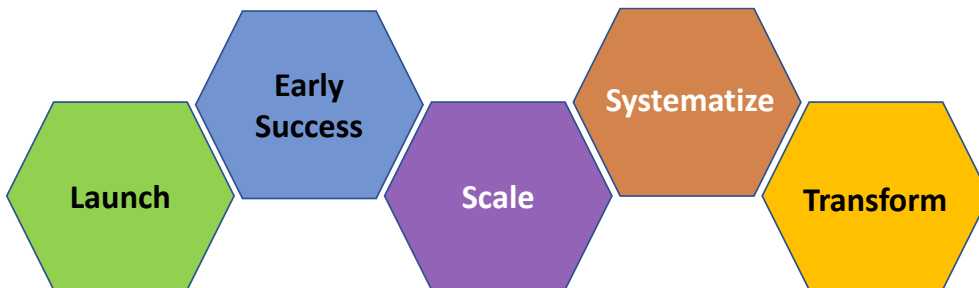
