WHEN: 3 days (8am - 4pm) at your convenience

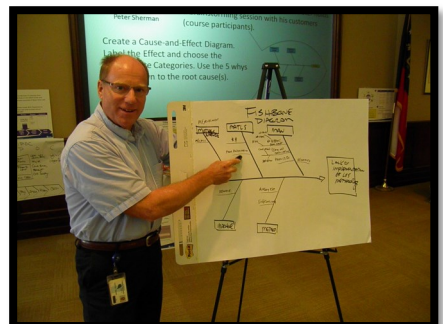
